





CUT OUT ANGLE GUIDE.


Cut out angle guide from cardboard carton for referencing the bend angles. Review the angle guide below for angle locations.



Step 02

BEND BACK PANEL.


Bend the angles on the back panel using the angle guide as shown.



ATTACH BACK PANEL TO SEAT.

Attach the back panel to the seat using the provided hardware as shown.


Do not fully tighten the bolts.






ALIGN PLASTIC SOCKETS.


Rotate the palstic sockets so they are aligned to receive leg assemblies as shown.




ATTACH UPPER LEG.

Attach the upper leg to the seat assembly using the provided hardware as shown. Ensure that the correct leg is being attached by referencing the diagram below.







Additional Information

CLEAN

Clean with a slightly damp, soft cloth. To remove dirt and fingerprints, use a quality cleaner formulated for metal furniture. Wipe completely dry with a soft cloth.

NOTE

The copper finish will be bright when new, and will naturally darken and patina with handling and age.
